

Information about investigations concerning violations in school

In Skollagen (Swedish school law) it is stated that if a person who works in a school is informed that a student finds him- or herself to have been subjected to a violation of some kind, that person must report the incident to the principal.

When the principal becomes aware that a student finds that he or she has been subjected to a violation, the principal must report this to the school administration in Uppsala kommun. The principal has a responsibility to investigate what has happened and to describe what actions will be taken concerning the violation. The principal must present a plan on how the school will ensure that the violation does not happen again

This investigation will be registered at the school administration in Uppsala kommun and the principal's manager will also be able to take part of the investigation.

An investigation concerning a violation in school has nothing to do with reporting to the police or to the social services.

At Liljeforsskolan, all staff has a responsibility to detect and prevent violations. When an investigation about a presumed violation begins, we always inform the students' parents or guardians. It is important that the school and the parents/guardians work together on these matters.

We also have a supportgroup; Stödgruppen, which meet once a week to talk about any violations that may have occurred and that must be reported to the principal. Stödgruppen also plan forward concerning working methods to prevent violations and to ensure that our school is a place where all students feel safe and experience a good learning environment.
